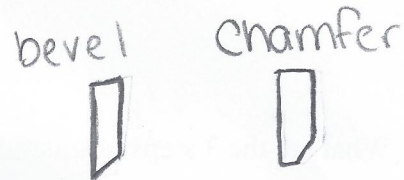


Jointer

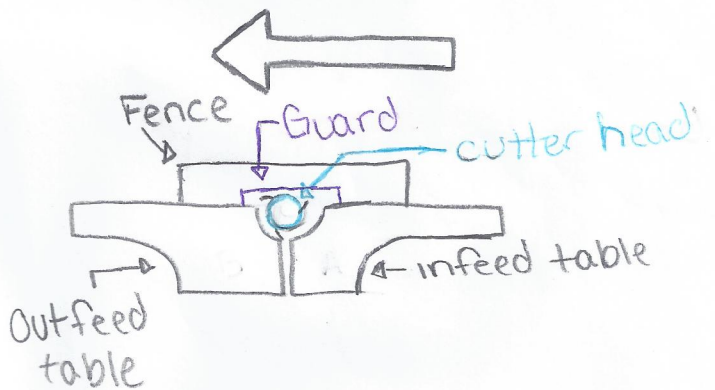
I. Use

- ★ A. jointing edge grain
- B. bevel and chamfer



II. Parts and a working relationship

- A. Infeed table
- B. Outfeed table
- C. cutter head
- D. fence and guard

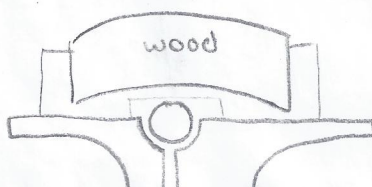


*** Do NOT adjust the outfeed table

III. A jointer is sized by length of knives

IV. Procedures for use

- A. Stock must be at least 12" in length
- B. Check fence for square using a try square
- C. Check fence for angle cuts using a sliding T bevel
- D. Rough cut maximum 1/8" Finish cut 1/16"
- E. Warped pieces: concave side goes down



F. Exhaust fan on and guard in place

G. Hand placement

H. Feed work at proper speed. (Too fast will cause ripples)
